

AHD cases: Well Child / Rash / GU / Seizure-Paroxysmal Event

1. A mother with an 11 month old child wonders what she should do to “child proof” the house.
2. The parents of with three un-immunized children (aged 2 months old, 2 years old, and 5 years old) schedule an appointment to discuss whether their children should be vaccinated.
3. A 3 year old child presents with her mother with a complaint of a sore ear. You notice that the child has several dental caries.
4. An 18 month old child is brought to the ED because “she went blue and stopped breathing”.
5. A 2 year old boy is brought to your clinic because the mother is concerned about his limited diet. He eats bread, pasta, apple sauce, and cheese. He drinks four 16 ounce bottles of milk per day.
6. An 8 year old boy presents with enuresis. His parents are very concerned.
